Seattle Public Schools (SPS) invites families and community members to attend meetings to discuss options for capital projects that may be included in the next capital levy, planned for February 2010.

This will be the first opportunity to provide ideas and input for projects to be included in the February 2010 levy. Seattle voters have supported capital levies and bonds on a three-year cycle since 1995. Building Excellence I (1995), II (2001) and III (2008) funded historic renovation or new construction at more than 30 schools. Buildings, Technology and Athletic Fields (BTA I – 1998) and Buildings, Technology and Academics (BTA II – 2004) funded more than 1100 projects at schools across the district. BTA included projects such as roof and window replacement, HVAC and seismic upgrades, and upgrades to science labs and athletic fields.
