Biking Improvements Coming to SW Morgan Street

Summer 2012

The Seattle Department of Transportation is planning changes to make riding bicycles safer and more convenient along SW Morgan Street between Fauntleroy Way SW and 35th Avenue SW. The proposed changes are outlined below. Implementation is expected to occur later this summer.



Parking (see map on reverse)

- On-street parking will be consolidated to the north side
 - Parking on the south side of the street will be eliminated
 - Parking on the north side of the street will remain
- Parking will be added on the north side of the street between 36th Avenue SW and the U-Haul driveway

Bicycle Lanes

- Dedicated buffered bicycle lanes will be provided eastbound between Fauntleroy Way SW and 35th Avenue SW
- Bicycle sharrows (or shared lane markings) will be provided westbound between 35th Avenue SW and 42nd Avenue SW

Pedestrians

- The existing crosswalks at 35th Avenue SW and 42nd Avenue SW will also be remarked

These changes may impact how you or your guests park vehicles. SDOT has conducted parking studies that showed peak parking demand will continue to be accommodated with the parking that will remain on the north side of the street. A map highlighting the new on-street parking configuration is on the other side of this page.
