[Chelan Ave SW, W Marginal Way, SW Spokane St and Delridge Way SW]

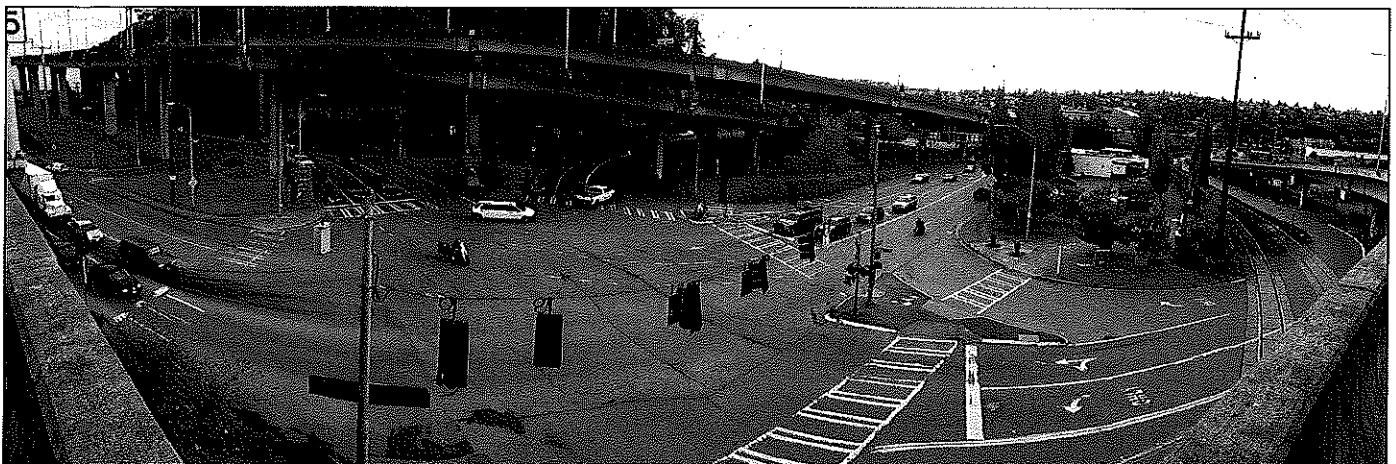
