

NOTICE OF UPCOMING WORK

Repairs to sewer line on 35th Ave. SW

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) will be making repairs to a sewer line along 35th Ave SW, between SW Juneau St. and SW Raymond St. The mainline at this location is damaged and requires replacement. Homes and businesses will continue to receive normal service during the repair.

SCHEDULE

Work is scheduled to begin on May 31. We anticipate the repair will take two weeks to complete, but weather may extend the schedule. After the initial work is complete, a steel plate will cover the repairs until the contractor returns to restore the pavement. Regular work hours are Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

LOCATION

Five locations along 35th Ave SW, between SW Juneau St. and SW Raymond St.



ANTICIPATED IMPACTS

Homes and businesses will continue to receive normal sewer services during construction.

However, you can expect:

- Limited access to driveways during construction work hours.
- The center two lanes of 35th Ave SW will be closed to traffic during work hours.
- Temporary parking restrictions.
- Increased construction traffic, noise, dirt and vibrations.
- Pavement excavation and restoration.
