- High-quality teaching and learning are keys to student success - provide best possible educational environment for staff to lead and support student development;

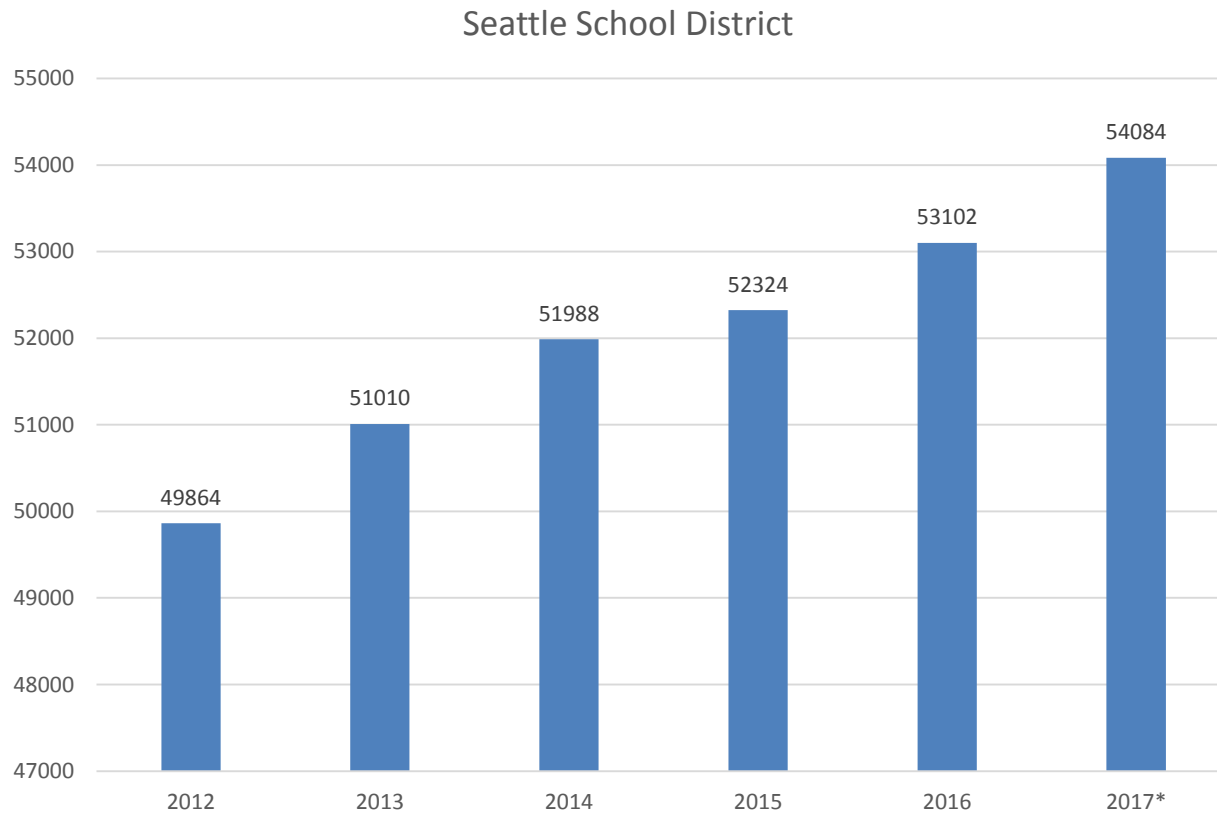
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- High-performing District includes effective leadership, accountability, effective organizational systems and an engaged community - Involve the school and community in the design of their new facility;
- Systems improvements - Manage resources in a fiscally prudent manner and search for opportunities to minimize use of local taxes.

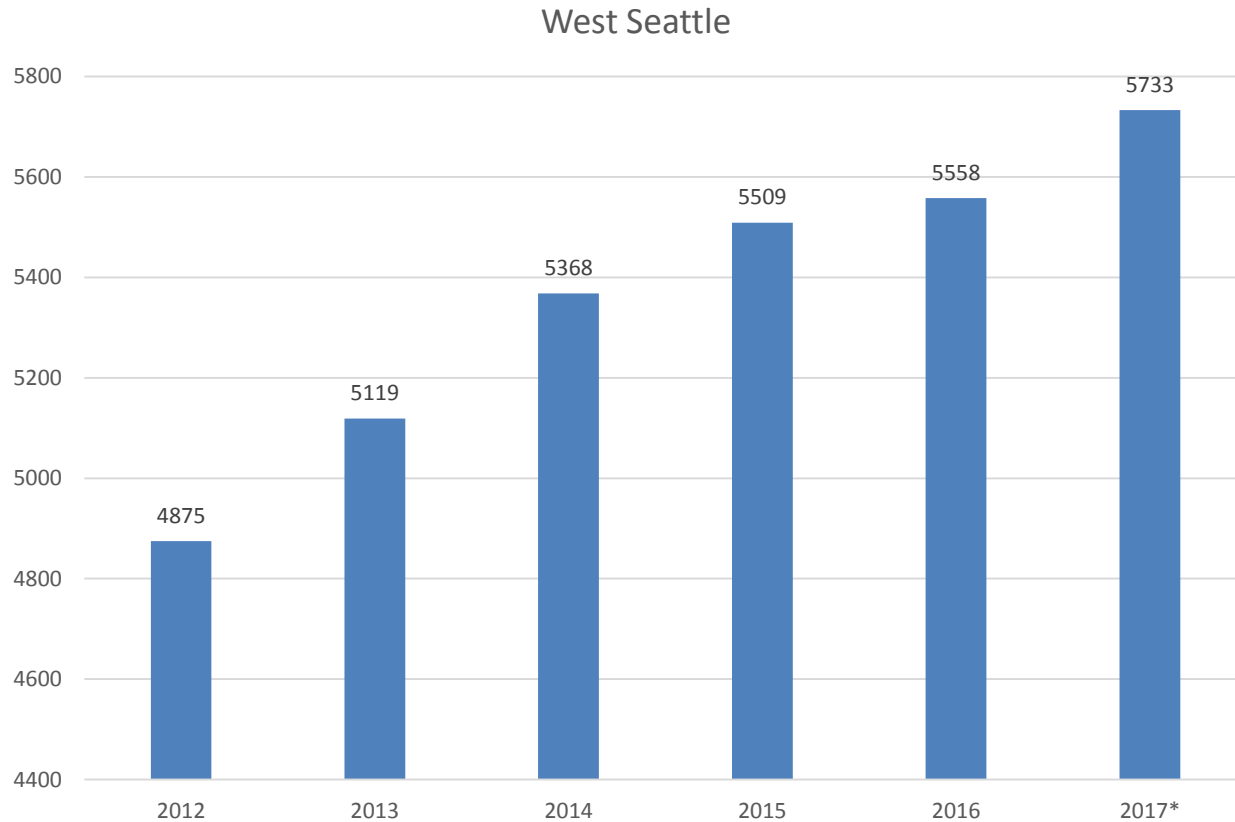
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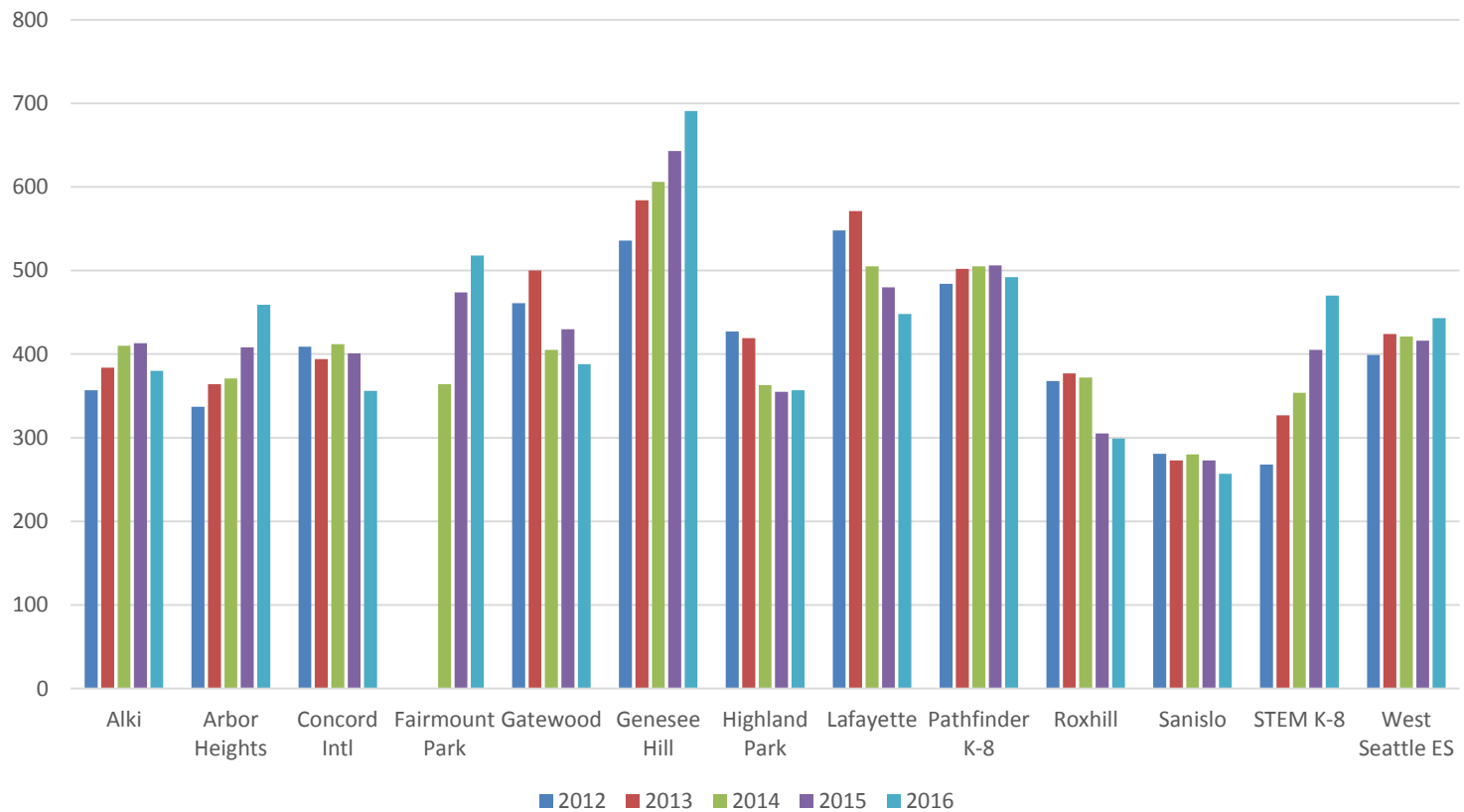
