Over the next several months, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) intends to install signs along portions of Harbor Avenue SW to restrict overnight parking adjacent to non-residential, non-commercial uses. The signs to be installed will match signs that already exist in other portions of the corridor. Where installed they will restrict vehicles from parking between the hours of 11 pm and 5 am.

This work is an outcome of ongoing conversations multiple departments of the City of Seattle have had with a variety of community members. The intent is to ensure safe and reliable daytime access to amenities such as the waterfront, the bicycle and pedestrian pathway along the east side of Harbor Avenue SW, and the variety of greenspaces along the corridor, and to allow and facilitate daytime uses of those amenities while limiting overnight access.
